AUGMENTATION OF THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED USES  
AND FIRE PROTECTION.

ALTERNATE POINTS OF DIVERSION:

- 1) THE POINT AT WHICH WILDCAT CREEK ENTERS  
THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4NW1/4,  
SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 14 S., RANGE 86 W., 6<sup>TH</sup> PM
- 2) THE POINT AT WHICH WILDCAT CREEK IS CROSSED  
BY WILDCAT TRAIL IN THE SE1/4SW1/4, SECTION 4,  
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 86 WEST, 6<sup>TH</sup> PM
