John Flanigan called the meeting to order at 11:02 am and confirmed a quorum. Scott confirmed notice of the meeting had been displayed on the website. John said there were no additions to the Agenda and no members of the public had chosen to participate in the meeting.

Julie Behrens made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2020 meeting. John Flanigan seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
