Discussion took place regarding the recommendations made by Summit attorney, Jon Schumacher, regarding possible amendments to the Summit Bylaws. The amendments would give the association the ability to levy fines for infractions of the association articles, specifically as they relate to parking of cars. Parking of cars is only allowed in driveways and not on the street or in adjacent lots. After discussion, the board agreed that they fine system should be amended to include the following steps: 1) Written Warning, 2) 2<sup>nd</sup> offense \$100 fine, 3) 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - \$20 per day fine. Don Baker will review the document from Schumacher and draft the changes for future approval by the Board of Directors.
